Description

It was organized by the Bulgarian History Teachers' Association, Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs of Greece, Mémorial de la Shoah and the Holocaust Fund of the Jews of Macedonia.

It was for the first time that the Bulgarian educators were invited by the Greek ministry of education for a common event in Kavala.

Among the topics debated were the aftermath of WWII in both countries, the Greek civil war and the killing actions against civilians in Doxato. The organizers have decided to have another round next year in Sofia.

A common learning activity on Jewish communities in both countries was developed and implemented 6 months after the end of this training among the groups of teachers. This is new tool done by the teachers for the teachers.
