Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

This is the first edition of this regional dialogue between two museums and one remembrance organization. The memory of Nazi and Stalinist crimes were at the heart of the discussion. A group of volunteers have initiated and completed a common learning activity for the group of teachers about the European matrix of anti-Judaism. It is one of the goals of this regional dialogue to create a dedicated tool coming from the knowledge disseminated. Moreover, many of the trainees visited for the first time the Panerai site, a major place of remembrance for the Jews but also for the poles and the Lithuanians. Another highlight of the training was definitely the fruitful debate about the most important myth in this region, the judeobolchevism.
