This project is a common endeavor from the House of Wannsee conference, OFAJ and Memorial de la Shoah. France and Germany have many educational challenges related to the Holocaust teaching (inclusive approach for non-European audience, Holocaust distortion, competing memories rise of far-right). This dialogue aims at strengthening the know-how by exchanging practices. The educators			

debated about gender violence within the Holocaust, conspiracy theory, and Historikerstreit 2.0. The training took place in the premises of the Memorial de la Shoah and included an historical site visit of Jewish life before WWII.
